- (n) (1) The Board may publish a summary of any allegations of grounds for disciplinary or other action.
 - (2) A summary may not identify:
- (i) Any person who makes an allegation to the Board or any of its investigatory bodies;
 - (ii) A licensed physician about whom an allegation is made; or
- (iii) A witness in an investigation or a proceeding before the Board or any of its investigatory bodies.
- (e) The Board shall disclose information in a record upon the request of the Governor, Secretary, or Legislative Auditor, in accordance with § 2–1223(a) of the State Government Article. However, the Governor, Secretary, or Auditor, or any of their employees may not disclose personally identifiable information from any of these records which are otherwise confidential by law.
 - (p) This section does not apply to:
- (1) Any disclosure of a record by the Board to any of its investigatory bodies; or
- (2) A licensee, certificate holder, or registration holder who has been charged under this title or a party to a proceeding before the Board who claims to be aggrieved by the decision of the Board.
- (q) If any information contained in-any medical or hospital document or any other exhibit is otherwise open for disclosure under law, the use of that document or exhibit in any record of the Board or any of its investigatory bodies does not prevent its disclosure in any other proceeding.

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- $\underline{\text{(b)}}$ $\underline{\text{(2)}}$ $\underline{\text{(I)}}$ The Board shall keep a list of all physicians who are currently licensed.
- (II) THE LIST SHALL INCLUDE EACH PHYSICIAN'S DESIGNATED PUBLIC ADDRESS.
- (III) A PHYSICIAN'S DESIGNATED PUBLIC ADDRESS MAY BE A POST OFFICE BOX ONLY IF THE PHYSICIAN PROVIDES TO THE BOARD A NONPUBLIC ADDRESS, UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THAT IS NOT A POST OFFICE BOX.
- (IV) Each list prepared under this [subsection] PARAGRAPH shall be kept as a permanent record of the Board.
 - (V) The list of currently licensed physicians is a public record.
- (3) (I) THE BOARD SHALL MAINTAIN ON FILE A PHYSICIAN'S DESIGNATED NONPUBLIC ADDRESS, IF PROVIDED BY THE PHYSICIAN, TO FACILITATE COMMUNICATION BETWEEN THE PHYSICIAN AND THE BOARD.
