

2. The owner or operator of the landfill retains a record that clearly delineates where the asbestos has been deposited;

(ii) White goods; and

(iii) Subject to § 9-228(f) of this subtitle, scrap tires.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 533

(House Bill 1025)

AN ACT concerning

Environment - Drinking Water

FOR the purpose of altering the definition of a public water system; defining certain terms; requiring each public supplier of water to provide certain public notice if a certain system fails to meet certain standards; prohibiting a supplier of water from making a false representation to the Department of Environment; prohibiting a person from tampering with a public water system; imposing certain civil penalties for tampering with a public water system; imposing certain criminal penalties for making a false representation to the Department; ~~authorizing the Department to impose certain administrative penalties for certain violations related to safe drinking water;~~ authorizing the Department to impose certain administrative penalties for certain violations related to safe drinking water; providing for hearing and appeal procedures related to administrative ~~penalties~~ penalties and orders; imposing certain performance requirements on new public water systems after a certain date; making a portion of this Act contingent on the taking effect of certain federal regulations; and generally relating to public water systems and drinking water standards and requirements.
