

(10) The Investigative Services Unit of the Comptroller's Office;

(11) Housing Authority of Baltimore City Police Force; [or]

(12) The Crofton Police Department[.];

(13) THE POLICE OFFICERS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE;

(14) THE POLICE OFFICERS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES;

(15) THE POLICE OFFICERS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, LICENSING, AND REGULATION; OR

(16) FULL-TIME INVESTIGATIVE ASSISTANTS AND INSPECTION ASSISTANTS IN THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL'S OFFICE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 536

(House Bill 1044)

AN ACT concerning

State Personnel - Family and Medical Leave

FOR the purpose of altering a certain provision of law to allow, and not require, regulations adopted by the Secretary of Budget and Management implementing the federal Family and Medical Leave Act of 1993 to require eligible State employees to use other available accrued leave concurrently with family and medical leave; and generally relating to family and medical leave.
