

Article 38A - Fires and Investigations

8.

(m) (1) [The] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE State Fire Marshal shall:

 (1)(I) Collect the fees established by the State Fire Prevention Commission for conducting inspections;

 (2)(II) Keep records of all fees collected under this subsection; and

 (3)(III) Pay all moneys collected under this subsection into the General Fund of the State.

(2) THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL MAY NOT COLLECT A FEE FOR CONDUCTING AN INSPECTION OF PROPERTY THAT IS OWNED BY:

(I) THE STATE, A COUNTY, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, OR A NONPROFIT ENTITY; COUNTY, OR A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION; OR

(II) A FIRE, RESCUE, OR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ENTITY, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE ENTITY IS GOVERNMENT AFFILIATED OR VOLUNTEER A GOVERNMENT-AFFILIATED OR VOLUNTEER FIRE, RESCUE, OR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ENTITY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

Criminal Procedure - Witnesses - Notification of Release and Escape of Offender

FOR the purpose of ~~requiring a supervising authority to provide certain notice if a person convicted of a certain crime of violence escapes from a facility or the custody of a supervising authority; requiring that certain persons receive notification; requiring notice information to be confidential; requiring notice of recapture of an offender; requiring the Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services to adopt certain regulations; defining certain terms; and generally relating to notice of escape of certain criminal offenders under certain circumstances authorizing a State's Attorney to provide a State's witness with a copy of certain guidelines; allowing certain witnesses to request a certain notice~~
