of a defendant's release under certain circumstances; requiring certain commitment agencies provide certain notices to witnesses and to notify certain witnesses of a defendant's release, escape, recapture, transfer, or death under certain circumstances; establishing that this Act does not create certain causes of action providing certain immunity for elected public officials, public employees, and public agencies; establishing that certain victims and witnesses of delinquent acts should be notified of certain releases and escapes; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the notification of witnesses of certain releases of defendants from custody.
