- (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic structures.
- (b) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 547

(House Bill 1173)

AN ACT concerning

Medical and Chirurgical Faculty of Maryland - Physician Rehabilitation Program and Peer Review Activities - Audit

FOR the purpose of altering the time period within which auditors are required to audit the accounts and transactions of the Medical and Chirurgical Faculty of Maryland for the physician rehabilitation program and peer review activities.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

14-402.

(e) (2) The Legislative Auditor shall [annually] EVERY 2 YEARS audit the accounts and transactions of the Faculty for the physician rehabilitation program and peer review activities as provided in § 2–1220 of the State Government Article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.
