- (iii) One member appointed by the State Senators whose districts are within or include part of Washington County;
- (iv) One member from Washington County to represent restaurants, taverns, and the alcoholic beverages industry in the County, appointed by the Washington County House and Senate Delegations; and
- (v) One member from the Washington County Clubs Association, appointed by the Washington County House and Senate Delegations.

- (2) A member of the Commission appointed under paragraph (1)(i), (ii), or (iii) of this subsection may not:
  - Hold a tip jar license or a wholesaler's license;
- (ii) Be employed by a person who holds a tip jar license or a wholesaler's license;
- (iii) Hold any ownership interest in or receive any direct benefit from the holder of a tip jar license or a wholesaler's license; or
- (iv) Serve on any board of directors or as an officer of any organization that [is qualified under § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code] APPLIES FOR FUNDS FROM THE COMMISSION.
- (3) IF AN ORGANIZATION, THAT HAS ON ITS BOARD OF DIRECTORS OR AS AN OFFICER A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION, APPLIES FOR FUNDS FROM THE COMMISSION DURING THE MEMBER'S TERM, THE MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION MAY NO LONGER SERVE ON THE COMMISSION AND A NEW MEMBER SHALL BE APPOINTED TO COMPLETE THE TERM.
- [(3)](4) A member of the Commission shall be a resident of Washington County.
- [(4)] (5) The term of a member of the Commission is 2 years and begins on July 1.
- [(5)](6) A member of the Commission may not be reappointed within 5 years after completion of [a full 2-year term] TWO 2-YEAR TERMS.
- [(6)](7) The terms of members of the Commission are staggered as required by the terms in effect for members of the Commission on July 1, 1995.
- [(7)](8) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed.
- [(8)] (9) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed.
  - [(9)](10) A member of the commission:
    - (i) May not receive compensation; but
