

(I) A CORPORATE OR LIMITED LIABILITY ENTITY APPLICANT, IF 50% OR MORE OF THE CAPITAL STOCK IS OWNED BY THE INDIVIDUAL WHOSE LICENSE WAS REVOKED OR BY THE IMMEDIATE FAMILY OF THAT INDIVIDUAL; OR

(II) A PARTNERSHIP APPLICANT, IF THE INDIVIDUAL WHOSE LICENSE WAS REVOKED IS A PARTNER.

(u) (1) Before the County agency may take action under subsection (s) of this section, the County agency shall give the person against whom the action is contemplated the opportunity for a hearing before the Board.

(2) On request, the Board shall hold a hearing in the same manner as specified in Title 10, Subtitle 2 of the State Government Article OR MAY DELEGATE THE AUTHORITY TO HOLD THE HEARING TO THE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS.

(3) [The] IF THE BOARD HOLDS A HEARING UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, THE Board may administer oaths [in a proceeding under this subsection].

(4) IF THE BOARD DELEGATES THE AUTHORITY TO HOLD THE HEARING TO THE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS:

(I) THE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE SHALL STATE ON THE RECORD THE FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW;

(II) THE DETERMINATION OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE IS A FINAL DECISION FOR THE PURPOSE OF JUDICIAL REVIEW OF A FINAL DECISION IN A CONTESTED CASE UNDER § 10-222 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE; AND

(III) JUDICIAL REVIEW OF DISPUTED ISSUES OF FACT SHALL BE CONFINED TO THE RECORD FOR JUDICIAL REVIEW, UNLESS THE FINES EXCEED \$5,000 IN WHICH CASE JUDICIAL REVIEW SHALL BE DE NOVO.

[(4)] (5) If, after notice is given, the person against whom the action is contemplated:

(I) [does] DOES not appear, nevertheless the Board may hear and determine the matter; OR

(II) DOES NOT REQUEST A HEARING, THE BOARD MAY DEEM THAT THE MATTER HAS BEEN HEARD AND MAY IMPOSE A FINE.

(v) (1) A person who does not hold a wholesaler's license may not sell or wholesale for profit a tip jar packet.

(2) A person who does not hold a tip jar license may not offer to another person a chance from a tip jar or otherwise operate a tip jar.

(3) A person who holds a tip jar license may not:

(i) Allow an individual under the age of 18 years to play a tip jar;

or
