SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

26 - 201.

- (a) Except as provided in [subsections (b) and (c)] SUBSECTION (B) of this section, this subtitle applies only to:
- (1) an employee of the Department of Natural Resources commissioned by the Secretary of Natural Resources as:
 - (i) a Natural Resources police officer; or
- (ii) a law enforcement officer, other than a Natural Resources police officer;
- (2) a law enforcement officer employed by the Maryland Investigative Services Unit:
