- (f) (1) Any person sentenced to home detention shall be responsible for the person's medical care and related expenses, costs of housing, food, lodging, clothing, and transportation, restitution, and taxes while participating in the home detention program.
- (2) (i) The Sheriff may collect a reasonable fee from each person participating in the home detention program.
- (ii) The Sheriff may waive or reduce a fee imposed under subparagraph (i) of this paragraph.
- (3) The Sheriff may determine the maximum number of persons that may participate in the program.
- (g) A person who knowingly or willfully violates a term or condition of the home detention program:
- (1) Is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is subject to a fine of not more than \$10,000 or imprisonment for up to 1 year or both; and
 - (2) Is subject to any other disciplinary action provided by law.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 560

(House Bill 1399)

AN ACT concerning

State Fire Marshal - Full-Time Investigative and Inspection Assistants Powers of Arrest

FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Fire Marshal and certain full-time investigative and inspection assistants of the Office of the State Fire Marshal to make warrantless arrests, conduct investigations, and enforce certain laws without jurisdictional limitations under certain circumstances; making the Law Enforcement Officers' Bill of Rights applicable to the State Fire Marshal and certain full-time investigative and inspection assistants of the Office of the State Fire Marshal; making certain laws relating to the Police Training Commission applicable to the State Fire Marshal and certain full-time investigative and inspection assistants of the Office of the State Fire Marshal; and generally relating to the State Fire Marshal and full-time investigative and inspection assistants of the Office of the State Fire Marshal.
