(II) EXCEPT ON INTERSTATE HIGHWAYS, A COMBINATION OF VEHICLES WITH A SEMITRAILER LENGTH OF 45 FEET OR LESS CARRYING FOREST PRODUCTS THAT HAVE BEEN LOADED IN FORESTS OR OTHER SIMILAR OFF-HIGHWAY LOCATIONS IS PERMITTED AN AXLE LOAD LIMIT TOLERANCE OF 5 PERCENT FROM § 24–109(B) AND (C) OF THIS SUBTITLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

## **CHAPTER 564**

(Senate Bill 18)

## AN ACT concerning

## Condominiums and Homeowners Associations - Rights and Restrictions

FOR the purpose of authorizing condominium unit owners and homeowners association lot owners to assemble meet in certain areas for certain purposes and under certain circumstances; requiring certain governing bodies or committees of condominiums and homeowners associations to designate a period of time during certain meetings to allow an opportunity to comment on certain metters requiring certain governing bodies and committees of condominiums to allow unit owners to comment on certain matters during certain meetings, subject to certain rules; requiring certain governing bodies and committees of homeowners associations to allow property lot owners to comment on certain matters during certain meetings, subject to certain rules; authorizing unit owners and lot owners to distribute information and circulate petitions at in certain places and in certain ways, subject to certain rules; defining certain terms; and generally relating to rights of condominium unit owners and homeowners association lot owners.
