

(2) (I) BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 1999, THE CITY OF BALTIMORE SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING AT LEAST \$800,000 IN EACH FISCAL YEAR TO SUPPORT EDUCATION AT THE BALTIMORE CITY COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

(II) OF THIS AMOUNT, IN EACH FISCAL YEAR, AT LEAST \$500,000 SHALL BE EXPENDED AND ADMINISTERED BY THE COLLEGE FOR TUITION REIMBURSEMENT OR SCHOLARSHIPS TO ATTEND CLASSES AT THE BALTIMORE CITY COMMUNITY COLLEGE, AND THE REMAINING BALANCE SHALL BE EXPENDED IN A MANNER CONSISTENT WITH THE EDUCATIONAL MISSION OF THE BALTIMORE CITY COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

(III) THE SOURCE OF THE \$800,000 IS NOT LIMITED TO TAX OR FEE REVENUES GENERATED BY THE CITY OF BALTIMORE.

### Chapter 220 of the Acts of 1990

[SECTION 10. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the City of Baltimore shall expend at least \$300,000 in each fiscal year for tuition reimbursement or scholarships to attend classes at the New Community College of Baltimore.]

### Chapter 208 of the Acts of 1992

[SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the City of Baltimore shall be responsible for providing at least \$600,000 in each fiscal year to support education at the Baltimore City Community College. Of this amount, in each fiscal year, at least \$300,000 shall be expended for tuition reimbursement or scholarships to attend classes at the Baltimore City Community College and the remaining balance shall be expended in a manner consistent with the educational mission of the Baltimore City Community College. The source of the \$600,000 is not limited to tax or fee revenues generated by the City of Baltimore.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1998.

(House Bill 256)

### **Higher Education - Baltimore City Community College - Funding**
