

CHAPTER 573

(Senate Bill 176)

AN ACT concerning

State Government - Department of Aging

FOR the purpose of removing the Office on Aging from the Executive Department; creating the Department of Aging as a principal department of State government; directing the Secretary of Aging to report directly to the Governor; requiring the Department to report on a strategic plan that includes certain recommendations on or before a certain date; stating the intent of the General Assembly; specifying that the publisher of the Annotated Code of Maryland, in consultation with the Department of Legislative Services, shall correct agency names and titles in the Code to conform to the changes that are made by this Act; and generally relating to the Department of Aging.
