- (ii) If the facility is not in operation, the expected date of opening and a description of the specific services and facilities that will be available upon opening.
- (C) A PERSON WHO REGISTERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 14–12B–02(B)(3)(III) OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL POST IN A CLEAR AND CONSPICUOUS MANNER A SIGN IN A PROMINENT LOCATION IN EACH HEALTH CLUB FACILITY THAT THE PERSON OPENS OR OPERATES THAT STATES THAT THE FACILITY DOES NOT:
- (1) CHARGE AN INITIATION FEE OR OTHER FEE THAT IS NOT IDENTIFIED AS A PAYMENT FOR SPECIFIC FUTURE SERVICES;
- (2) OBLIGATE THE BUYER TO PURCHASE MORE THAN 1 MONTH'S HEALTH-CLUB SERVICES; OR
- $\frac{(3)}{\text{SERVICES}}$ COLLECT MORE THAN 1 MONTH'S PAYMENT IN ADVANCE FOR SERVICES.
- (2) CONTRACTUALLY OBLIGATE A BUYER OF HEALTH CLUB SERVICES TO PAY IN ADVANCE OF THE DATE THE SERVICES ARE PROVIDED TO THE BUYER; OR
- (3) COLLECT FROM A BUYER OF HEALTH CLUB SERVICES ANY PAYMENT IN ADVANCE OF THE DATE THE SERVICES ARE PROVIDED TO THE BUYER

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this Act do not apply to any initial registration or renewal of registration until September 1, 1997 1998.

SECTION $\frac{2}{2}$. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 582

(Senate Bill 107)

AN ACT concerning

Enterprise Zones - Expansion

FOR the purpose of authorizing a political subdivision to apply to the Secretary of Business and Economic Development for an expansion of an enterprise zone; providing that for the manner of application and the requirements for the area for the proposed expansion of an enterprise zone are the same as the requirements for the designation of a new enterprise zone for an expansion of an enterprise zone; requiring that an area meet certain criteria to be included in an expansion of an enterprise zone; authorizing the Secretary to grant an extraordinary expansion of an enterprise zone under certain circumstances; providing that an extraordinary expansion of an enterprise zone does not count towards certain limitations on the number of enterprise zones that can be
