# Property Tax Exemption Baltimore City - Tax Credit - South Baltimore Little League

FOR the purpose of providing for an exemption from authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City to grant a property tax credit against the property tax imposed on certain property owned by the South Baltimore Little League and used for amateur sports; and providing for the application of this Act.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## PROPERTY IS NOT SUBJECT TO PROPERTY TAX IF THE PROPERTY IS:

- (b) The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City may grant, by law, a property tax credit under this section against the county property tax imposed on:
- (1) real property that is leased, occupied, and used only by the Baltimore Association for Retarded Citizens, Incorporated; AND
  - (2) PROPERTY THAT IS:
  - (1) OWNED BY THE SOUTH BALTIMORE LITTLE LEAGUE;
  - (2) (II) LOCATED AT 1101 E. FORT AVENUE, BALTIMORE, MARYLAND;
    - (3) (III) USED FOR AMATEUR SPORTS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1 June 1, 1998, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after June 30, 1998.
