(T) (S) HANDICAPPED.

"HANDICAPPED" MEANS HAVING A TEMPORARY OR PERMANENT PHYSICAL DISABILITY.

(U) (T) INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURE.

"INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURE" MEANS AN EXPENDITURE BY A PERSON OR POLITICAL COMMITTEE TO AID OR PROMOTE THE SUCCESS OR DEFEAT OF A CANDIDATE THAT IS NOT MADE IN COORDINATION WITH, OR AT THE REQUEST OR SUGGESTION OF, A CANDIDATE OR AUTHORIZED COMMITTEE OR AGENT OF THE CANDIDATE.

(V) (U) INFAMOUS CRIME.

"INFAMOUS CRIME" MEANS ANY FELONY, TREASON, PERJURY, OR ANY CRIME INVOLVING AN ELEMENT OF DECEIT, FRAUD, OR CORRUPTION.

(W) (V) LOCAL BOARD.

"LOCAL BOARD" MEANS A COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS.

(X) (W) MAJORITY PARTY.

"MAJORITY PARTY" MEANS THE POLITICAL PARTY TO WHICH THE INCUMBENT GOVERNOR BELONGS, IF THE INCUMBENT GOVERNOR IS A MEMBER OF A PRINCIPAL POLITICAL PARTY. IF THE INCUMBENT GOVERNOR IS NOT A MEMBER OF ONE OF THE TWO PRINCIPAL POLITICAL PARTIES, "MAJORITY PARTY" MEANS THE PRINCIPAL POLITICAL PARTY WHOSE CANDIDATE FOR GOVERNOR RECEIVED THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF VOTES OF ANY PARTY CANDIDATE AT THE LAST PRECEDING GENERAL ELECTION.

(Y) (X) PARTISAN ORGANIZATION.

"PARTISAN ORGANIZATION" MEANS A COMBINATION OF TWO OR MORE INDIVIDUALS FORMED FOR THE PURPOSE OF ORGANIZING A NEW POLITICAL PARTY.

(Z) (Y) POLITICAL COMMITTEE.

"POLITICAL COMMITTEE" MEANS A COMBINATION OF TWO OR MORE INDIVIDUALS THAT ASSISTS OR ATTEMPTS TO ASSIST IN PROMOTING THE SUCCESS OR DEFEAT OF A CANDIDATE, POLITICAL PARTY, OR QUESTION SUBMITTED TO A VOTE AT ANY ELECTION.

(AA) (Z) POLITICAL PARTY.

"POLITICAL PARTY" MEANS AN ORGANIZED GROUP THAT IS QUALIFIED AS A POLITICAL PARTY IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 4 OF THIS ARTICLE.

(BB) (AA) PRECINCT.

"PRECINCT" INCLUDES:
