

FORWARD THE APPLICATION, RENEWAL, OR CHANGE OF ADDRESS OR NAME FORM AS WELL AS A COPY OF THE RELEVANT PART OF THE LICENSE APPLICATION TO THE APPROPRIATE ELECTION OFFICIAL.

(E) FAILURE TO REGISTER TO VOTE.

INFORMATION RELATING TO THE FAILURE OF AN APPLICANT FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD TO REGISTER TO VOTE MAY NOT BE USED FOR ANY PURPOSE OTHER THAN THE MAINTENANCE OF REGISTRATION STATISTICS.

3-204. APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION AT VOTER REGISTRATION AGENCY.

(A) DESIGNATION.

(1) THE STATE BOARD SHALL DESIGNATE PUBLIC AGENCIES AND NONGOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES AS VOTER REGISTRATION AGENCIES WHERE QUALIFIED INDIVIDUALS MAY APPLY TO REGISTER TO VOTE.

(2) THE STATE BOARD SHALL DESIGNATE THE FOLLOWING OFFICES AS VOTER REGISTRATION AGENCIES:

(I) ALL OFFICES IN THE STATE THAT PROVIDE PUBLIC ASSISTANCE; AND

(II) ALL OFFICES IN THE STATE THAT PROVIDE STATE-FUNDED PROGRAMS PRIMARILY ENGAGED IN PROVIDING SERVICES TO INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES.

(3) THE STATE BOARD AND THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE SHALL JOINTLY DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT PROCEDURES FOR PERSONS TO APPLY TO REGISTER TO VOTE AT RECRUITMENT OFFICES OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES, WHICH SHALL BE DEEMED VOTER REGISTRATION AGENCIES.

(B) DUTIES OF AGENCIES; REGISTRATION DOCUMENTS.

EACH VOTER REGISTRATION AGENCY, AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (A)(2) AND (3) OF THIS SECTION, SHALL:

(1) DISTRIBUTE A VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATION APPROVED BY THE STATE BOARD OR THE FEDERAL ELECTION COMMISSION WITH EACH APPLICATION FOR SERVICE OR ASSISTANCE IT RENDERS AND WITH EACH RECERTIFICATION, RENEWAL, OR CHANGE OF ADDRESS FORM RELATING TO SUCH SERVICE OR ASSISTANCE;

(2) PROVIDE A DOCUMENT TO PROSPECTIVE REGISTRANTS THAT INCLUDES:

(I) THE QUESTION, "IF YOU ARE NOT REGISTERED TO VOTE WHERE YOU LIVE NOW, WOULD YOU LIKE TO APPLY TO REGISTER TO VOTE HERE TODAY?";
