SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

19 101.

- (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (b) "Board" means the State Board of Social Work Examiners.
- (c) (1) "License" means, unless the context requires otherwise, a license issued by the Board to practice social work.
 - (2) "License" includes:
 - (i) 1. A certified social worker license; or
 - 2. A certified social-worker clinical license;
 - (ii) Graduate social worker license: and
 - (iii) A social work associate license.
- (d) (1) "Licensed social worker" means, unless the context requires otherwise, a social worker who is licensed by the Board to practice social work.
 - (2) "LICENSED SOCIAL WORKER" INCLUDES:
 - (I) 1. A LICENSED CERTIFIED SOCIAL WORKER; OR
 - 2. A LICENSED CERTIFIED SOCIAL WORKER-CLINICAL:
 - (H) A LICENSED GRADUATE SOCIAL WORKER; AND
 - (III) A LICENSED SOCIAL WORK ASSOCIATE.
- (E) "LICENSED CLINICAL SOCIAL WORKER" MEANS A SOCIAL WORKER WHO IS LICENSED BY THE BOARD TO PRACTICE CLINICAL SOCIAL WORK.
- {(e)}(F) "Practice social work" means to engage professionally and for compensation in the following activities while representing oneself to be a social worker:
- (1) Helping individuals, groups, or communities to enhance or restore their capacity for social functioning;
 - (2) Seeking to create societal conditions favorable to this goal; and
