(B) CERTIFICATION REQUIRED UPON COMPLETION OF VERIFICATION $^{\mathfrak F}$ PROCESS.

UPON COMPLETION OF THE VERIFICATION PROCESS, THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS SHALL:

- (1) CERTIFY IN WRITING THAT THE ELECTION RESULTS ARE ACCURATE AND THAT THE VOTE HAS BEEN VERIFIED, AND
- (2) PROVIDE COPIES OF THE ELECTION RESULTS TO THE PERSONS SPECIFIED UNDER \S 11–401 OF THIS TITLE.
 - (C) DISSENT BY A LOCAL BOARD MEMBER WRITTEN STATEMENT REQUIRED.
- (1) IF A MEMBER OF A LOCAL BOARD OF CANVASSERS DISSENTS FROM A DETERMINATION OF AN ELECTION RESULT OR REASONABLY BELIEVES THAT THE CONDUCT OF A LOCAL BOARD MEMBER OR LOCAL BOARD PROCEEDING WAS NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE LAW OR REGULATION OR WAS OTHERWISE ILLEGAL OR IRREGULAR, THE MEMBER SHALL PREPARE AND FILE WITH THE LOCAL BOARD A DISTINCT WRITTEN STATEMENT OF THE REASONS FOR THE DISSENT OR CONCERN.
- (2) THE STATE BOARD SHALL MAINTAIN A FILE OF THE WRITTEN STATEMENTS SUBMITTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION BY MEMBERS OF THE LOCAL BOARDS.

SUBTITLE 4. CERTIFICATION OF ELECTION RESULTS BY LOCAL BOARD. 11–401. CERTIFIED COPIES OF RESULTS.

- (A) DISTRIBUTION OF CERTIFIED COPIES.
- (1) AFTER EACH ELECTION, EACH BOARD OF CANVASSERS SHALL TRANSMIT ONE CERTIFIED COPY OF THE ELECTION RESULTS IN ITS COUNTY, ATTESTED BY THE SIGNATURES OF THE CHAIRPERSON AND SECRETARY OF THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS, TO:
 - (I) THE GOVERNOR:
 - (II) THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS: AND
- (III) THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR THE APPROPRIATE COUNTY.
 - (2) THE STATEMENT MAY BE MAILED OR DELIVERED IN PERSON.
 - (B) TIME FOR TRANSMITTAL.
- (1) THE TRANSMITTAL SHALL BE MADE ON THE SECOND FRIDAY AFTER A PRIMARY OR GENERAL ELECTION OR, IF THE CANVASS IS COMPLETED AFTER THAT DATE, WITHIN 48 HOURS AFTER THE COMPLETION OF THE CANVASS.
- (2) AFTER A SPECIAL PRIMARY OR SPECIAL ELECTION, THE TRANSMITTAL SHALL BE MADE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, BUT NO LATER THAN THE SECOND THURSDAY AFTER THE ELECTION.
