11-502. BOARD OF STATE CANVASSERS.

(A) MEMBERSHIP.

THE BOARD OF STATE CANVASSERS CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:

- (1) THE SECRETARY OF STATE;
- (2) THE COMPTROLLER;
- (3) THE STATE TREASURER;
- (4) THE CLERK OF THE COURT OF APPEALS; AND
- (5) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.
- (B) QUORUM.

THREE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF STATE CANVASSERS CONSTITUTE A QUORUM.

(C) EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR STATE ADMINISTRATOR OF STATE BOARD TO SERVE AS SECRETARY.

THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR STATE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS SERVES AS SECRETARY TO THE BOARD OF STATE CANVASSERS.

(D) STATE TREASURER – APPOINTMENT OF DEPUTY AS DESIGNEE.

THE STATE TREASURER MAY APPOINT, AS THE TREASURER'S DESIGNEE, A DEPUTY TREASURER TO SERVE ON THE BOARD OF STATE CANVASSERS.

11-503. SAME - CANVASS OF ELECTION RESULTS:

(A) DUTIES.

THE BOARD OF STATE CANVASSERS SHALL:

- (1) (I) CONVENE ONLY AFTER A PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION, A STATE GENERAL ELECTION, OR A GENERAL OR SPECIAL GENERAL ELECTION THAT INCLUDES A CANDIDATE FOR MEMBER OF THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES;
 - (II) CONVENE WITHIN 35 DAYS OF THAT ELECTION; AND
- (III) IF A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF STATE CANVASSERS IS NOT PRESENT, ADJOURN FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 DAY;
- (2) DETERMINE WHICH CANDIDATES, BY THE GREATEST NUMBER OF VOTES, HAVE BEEN ELECTED TO EACH OFFICE AND WHICH QUESTIONS HAVE RECEIVED A SUFFICIENT NUMBER OF VOTES TO BE ADOPTED OR APPROVED;
