11-502. BOARD OF STATE CANVASSERS.

(A) MEMBERSHIP.

THE BOARD OF STATE CANVASSERS CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:

- (1) THE SECRETARY OF STATE;
- (2) THE COMPTROLLER;
- (3) THE STATE TREASURER;
- (4) THE CLERK OF THE COURT OF APPEALS; AND
- (5) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.

(B) QUORUM.

THREE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF STATE CANVASSERS CONSTITUTE A QUORUM.

(C) ~~EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR~~ STATE ADMINISTRATOR OF STATE BOARD TO SERVE AS SECRETARY.

THE ~~EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR~~ STATE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS SERVES AS SECRETARY TO THE BOARD OF STATE CANVASSERS.

(D) STATE TREASURER - APPOINTMENT OF DEPUTY AS DESIGNEE.

THE STATE TREASURER MAY APPOINT, AS THE TREASURER'S DESIGNEE, A DEPUTY TREASURER TO SERVE ON THE BOARD OF STATE CANVASSERS.

11-503. SAME - CANVASS OF ELECTION RESULTS.

(A) DUTIES.

THE BOARD OF STATE CANVASSERS SHALL:

(1) (I) CONVENE ONLY AFTER A PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION, A STATE GENERAL ELECTION, OR A GENERAL OR SPECIAL GENERAL ELECTION THAT INCLUDES A CANDIDATE FOR MEMBER OF THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES;

(II) CONVENE WITHIN 35 DAYS OF THAT ELECTION; AND

(III) IF A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF STATE CANVASSERS IS NOT PRESENT, ADJOURN FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 DAY;

(2) DETERMINE WHICH CANDIDATES, BY THE GREATEST NUMBER OF VOTES, HAVE BEEN ELECTED TO EACH OFFICE AND WHICH QUESTIONS HAVE RECEIVED A SUFFICIENT NUMBER OF VOTES TO BE ADOPTED OR APPROVED;
