### [31-7.] 15-107. PENALTY FOR VIOLATION.

On conviction of each violation of this [subtitle] TITLE, the violator shall be fined not more than \$5,000 or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both.

# [31-8.] 15-108. DISPOSITION OF REMAINING MONEY.

Any money remaining in the Fund after disbursements to candidates in a gubernatorial election shall be recredited to the Fund for the purposes provided in this [subtitle] TITLE.

# [31-9.] 15-109. CONTINUED ADMINISTRATION OF FUND BY COMPTROLLER.

- (a) (1) For [the taxable year beginning January 1, 1995 and each taxable year thereafter, for] every individual other than a nonresident alien filing a personal State income tax return, the Comptroller shall establish, FOR EACH TAXABLE YEAR, a tax add—on system that allows contributions to the Fair Campaign Financing Fund not to exceed \$500 per tax filer.
- (2) In accordance with the provisions of this [subtitle] TITLE, the Comptroller shall:
- (i) Credit to the Fund all money collected pursuant to these provisions; and
- (ii) Make disbursements from the Fund promptly upon receipt of an authorized request from the State [Administrative] Board [of Election Laws].
- (b) The Comptroller shall administer the Fund and invest the money in the Fund, subject to the usual investing procedures for State funds.

#### [31-10.] 15-110. SHORT TITLE.

This [subtitle] TITLE may be cited as the **Fair Campaign** <u>PUBLIC</u> PUBLIC Financing Act.

### TITLE 16. OFFENSES AND PENALTIES.

#### SUBTITLE 1. VOTER REGISTRATION.

## 16-101. OFFENSES RELATING TO REGISTRATION.

#### (A) GENERALLY.

## A PERSON MAY NOT WILLFULLY AND KNOWINGLY:

- (1) IMPERSONATE A VOTER OR OTHER PERSON IN ORDER TO REGISTER OR ATTEMPT TO REGISTER IN THE NAME OF THE VOTER OR OTHER PERSON;
  - (2) REGISTER TO VOTE MORE THAN ONCE;
- (3) FALSIFY RESIDENCE IN AN ATTEMPT TO REGISTER IN THE WRONG LOCATION;
