

(E) PENALTIES.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT IN THE PENITENTIARY FOR NOT LESS THAN 1 YEAR NOR MORE THAN 10 YEARS.

SUBTITLE 8. VOTING EQUIPMENT.

16-801. DESTRUCTION OF VOTING EQUIPMENT.

(A) GENERALLY.

A PERSON MAY NOT WILLFULLY:

(1) CONCEAL, DAMAGE, OR DESTROY VOTING EQUIPMENT USED OR INTENDED TO BE USED ON THE DAY OF ELECTION; OR

(2) REMOVE VOTING EQUIPMENT FROM THE CUSTODY OF THE ELECTION JUDGES OR OTHER ELECTION OFFICIALS.

(B) PENALTIES.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT IN THE PENITENTIARY FOR NOT LESS THAN 1 YEAR NOR MORE THAN 5 YEARS.

16-802. TAMPERING WITH VOTING EQUIPMENT.

(A) GENERALLY.

A PERSON MAY NOT WILLFULLY AND KNOWINGLY:

(1) TAMPER WITH, DAMAGE, OR ATTEMPT TO DAMAGE ANY VOTING EQUIPMENT THAT IS USED OR WILL BE USED IN AN ELECTION; OR

(2) PREVENT OR ATTEMPT TO PREVENT THE CORRECT OPERATION OF ANY VOTING EQUIPMENT THAT IS USED OR WILL BE USED ON THE DAY OF ELECTION.

(B) VOTING EQUIPMENT KEY.

AN UNAUTHORIZED PERSON MAY NOT MAKE OR HAVE IN THE PERSON'S POSSESSION A KEY TO ANY VOTING EQUIPMENT THAT IS USED OR WILL BE USED ON THE DAY OF ELECTION.

(C) PENALTIES.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR BOTH.

16-803. REMOVAL OR DESTRUCTION OF EQUIPMENT OR SUPPLIES.

(A) GENERALLY.
