

OF THIS SECTION, a person may not manufacture for distribution or sale any handgun that is not included on the handgun roster in the State.

(b) A person may not sell or offer for sale in the State a handgun manufactured after January 1, 1985 that is not on the handgun roster.

(c) A person may not manufacture, sell, or offer for sale any handgun on which the manufacturer's identification mark or number is obliterated, removed, changed, or otherwise altered.

(d) The Secretary may seek a permanent or temporary injunction from a circuit court to enjoin the willful and continuous manufacture, sale, or offer for sale, in violation of this section, of a handgun not included on the handgun roster.

(e) Subject to the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act, the Secretary of the State Police shall adopt rules and regulations necessary to carry out the provisions of this section and § 36J of this subheading.

(f) Nothing in this section shall be construed to interfere with:

(1) [a] A person's ability to:

(I) [manufacture] MANUFACTURE, sell, or offer to sell rifles or other weapons not defined as handguns in § 36F(b) of this article; OR

(II) MANUFACTURE PROTOTYPE HANDGUN MODELS REQUIRED FOR DESIGN, DEVELOPMENT, TESTING, AND APPROVAL BY THE BOARD; AND

(2) THE MANUFACTURING IN THE STATE OF A HANDGUN NOT ON THE HANDGUN ROSTER BY A FEDERALLY LICENSED GUN MANUFACTURER THAT WAS ALSO LICENSED AS A REGULATED FIREARMS DEALER IN THE STATE AS OF JANUARY 1, 1998, FOR DIRECT SALE TO A UNIT OF:

(I) THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT;

(II) A STATE OTHER THAN THE STATE OF MARYLAND;

(III) AN OUT-OF-STATE LOCAL GOVERNMENT; OR

(IV) AN OUT-OF-STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY.

(g) (1) Any person who manufactures a handgun for distribution or sale in violation of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than \$10,000 for each violation.

(2) Any person or entity who sells or offers to sell a handgun in violation of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than \$2,500 for each violation.

(3) For purposes of this subsection, each handgun manufactured, sold, or offered for sale in violation of this subsection shall be a separate violation.

(h) (1) A person or entity may not be held strictly liable for damages of any kind resulting from injuries to another person sustained as a result of the criminal
