**CHAPTER 620**

**(Senate Bill 610)**

AN ACT concerning

**New Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners - Chief Executive Officer**

FOR the purpose of allowing the interim Chief Executive Officer of the New Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners to be eligible for appointment as the permanent Chief Executive Officer of the Board; extending a certain deadline with respect to the appointment of a permanent Chief Executive Officer of the Board; making this Act an emergency measure; and relating generally to the appointment of the Chief Executive Officer of the New Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners.
