- (II) IF, AFTER EXAMINATION, THE PATIENTS PRESCRIPTION HAS NOT CHANGED SINCE THE LAST EXAMINATION, A LICENSED PHYSICIAN SHALL COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION WITHOUT REQUIRING THE PATIENT TO PURCHASE CONTACT LENSES OR TO UNDERGO IMMEDIATE FOLLOW-UP CARE.
- (2) (I) ON THE REQUEST OF A PATIENT OF A LICENSED PHYSICIAN, AND WITHOUT COST TO THE PATIENT, THE LICENSED PHYSICIAN SHALL PROVIDE TO A NAMED ACENT OF THE PATIENT A COPY OF THE PATIENT'S REPLACEMENT CONTACT LENS PRESCRIPTION.
- $\frac{(\mathrm{H})}{(2)} \quad \frac{(\mathrm{I})}{(\mathrm{I})} \quad \text{UPON THE $\frac{\text{WRITTEN}}{2}$ REQUEST OF A PATIENT OF A LICENSED PHYSICIAN, AND WITHOUT COST TO THE PATIENT, THE LICENSED PHYSICIAN SHALL PROVIDE TO A NAMED ACENT OF THE PATIENT A-COPY OF THE PATIENT'S REPLACEMENT CONTACT LENS PRESCRIPTION TO THE PATIENT OR THE PATIENT'S DESIGNEE.$
- (II) IN RESPONDING TO A REQUEST UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(I) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A LICENSED PHYSICIAN SHALL TRANSMIT THE CONTACT LENS PRESCRIPTION BY MAIL, TELEPHONE, FACSIMILE, E-MAIL, OR ANY OTHER MEANS OF COMMUNICATION THAT WILL, UNDER NORMAL CIRCUMSTANCES, RESULT IN THE DESIGNEE RECEIVING THE INFORMATION WITHIN 7 BUSINESS DAYS AFTER THE PATIENT'S REQUEST.
- (III) THE REPLACEMENT CONTACT LENS PRESCRIPTION THAT THE LICENSED PHYSICIAN PROVIDES THE PATIENT UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH:
- 1. SHALL CONTAIN THE INFORMATION NECESSARY FOR THE PROPER DUPLICATION OF THE CURRENT PRESCRIPTION OF THE PATIENT:
- 2. SHALL CONTAIN, SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, AN EXPIRATION DATE FOR THE REPLACEMENT CONTACT LENS PRESCRIPTION OF NOT MORE THAN 2 YEARS LESS THAN 18 MORE THAN 24 MONTHS FROM THE TIME THE PATIENT WAS FIRST EXAMINED: AND
- 3. MAY CONTAIN WEARING GUIDELINES OR SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE OF THE CONTACT LENSES BY THE PATIENT, OR BOTH.
- (D) THE LICENSED PHYSICIAN SHALL ENTER INTO THE PATIENT'S MEDICAL RECORD FOR THE VALID CLINICAL REASONS FOR A SHORTER EXPIRATION DATE AND SHALL PROVIDE THE PATIENT WITH A WRITTEN AND ORAL EXPLANATION OF THE CLINICAL REASONS FOR A SHORTER EXPIRATION DATE.
- (E) A LICENSED PHYSICIAN IS NOT LIABLE FOR AN INJURY TO OR A CONDITION OF A PATIENT OF THE LICENSED PHYSICIAN THAT RESULTS FROM NEGLIGENCE IN THE PACKACINC, MANUFACTURING, OR DISPENSING OF CONTACT LENSES BY A PERSON OTHER THAN THE LICENSED PHYSICIAN.
- (E) WHEN A PATIENT'S PRESCRIPTION IS DISPENSED BY A PERSON OTHER THAN THE LICENSED PHYSICIAN OR A PERSON ASSOCIATED DIRECTLY OR
