- 3. <u>WITHHOLD ALL OR PART OF THE CAPITATION RATE FROM</u>
 THE MANAGED CARE <u>ORGANIZATION;</u>
 - 4. TERMINATE THE PROVIDER AGREEMENT; OR
- 5. <u>DISQUALIFY THE MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATION FROM</u> FUTURE PARTICIPATION IN THE MARYLAND MEDICAID MANAGED CARE PROGRAM.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 632

(Senate Bill 664)

AN ACT concerning

Taxes - Property of the Housing Authorities Authority of Baltimore City

FOR the purpose of clarifying the applicability of a certain provision providing a tax exemption and providing for payments in lieu of taxes for property of a housing authority the Housing Authority of Baltimore City; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to a tax exemption and payments in lieu of taxes for certain property of a housing authority the Housing Authority of Baltimore City.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (a) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "ENTITY RELATED TO AN AUTHORITY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF BALTIMORE CITY" MEANS AN ENTITY:
- (I) THAT IS WHOLLY OWNED BY AN AUTHORITY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF BALTIMORE CITY; OR
- (II) IN WHICH AN AUTHORITY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF BALTIMORE CITY OR AN ENTITY WHOLLY OWNED BY AN AUTHORITY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF BALTIMORE CITY HAS AN OWNERSHIP INTEREST.
