- (C) TO DETERMINE THE APPROPRIATE LEVEL OF GENERAL FUND CONTRIBUTIONS FOR MEETING THE ACTUAL COSTS OF THE PROFESSIONAL INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM OF THE COLLEGE TO BE REQUESTED FROM THE EXECUTIVES AND LEGISLATURES OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND AND THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA, RESPECTIVELY, REVENUES ESTIMATED TO BE GENERATED BY TUITION FEES AND CHARGES, APPROPRIATE FEDERAL FUNDS, INSTRUCTIONAL FEES, AND OTHER INSTRUCTIONAL SOURCES OF INCOME SHALL BE SUBTRACTED FROM THE CALCULATIONS.
- (D) UPON VERIFICATION BY THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT OF THE ACCURACY OF THE ACTUAL COSTS OF THE PROFESSIONAL INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM OF THE COLLEGE, THE STATE OF MARYLAND SHALL PROVIDE THE APPROPRIATE LEVEL OF GENERAL FUNDS TO MEET THAT REQUIREMENT THE FINANCIAL REQUIREMENTS OF THE PROFESSIONAL INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM OF THE COLLEGE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Governor shall separately identify the college's budget within the University of Maryland, College Park's budget.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Governor shall separately include in the State operating budget funds that increase the College's State General Fund budget by the estimated actual costs, as determined by the Board and verified by the Department of Budget and Management Budget and Program Review Board of the Virginia-Maryland Regional College of Veterinary Medicine.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 643

(Senate Bill 715)

AN ACT concerning

Department of Human Resources - Maryland Emergency Food Program

FOR the purpose of establishing, subject to the limitations in the State budget, the Maryland Emergency Food Program in the State Department of Human Resources to provide grants to certain emergency food providers for a certain purpose; establishing a procedure for applying for grants and for allocating Program funds; requiring certain reports; and generally relating to establishing the Maryland Emergency Food Program.
