SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 88A - Department of Human Resources

MARYLAND EMERGENCY FOOD PROGRAM

- (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (B) "ADMINISTERING AGENCY" MEANS A LOCAL LEAD AGENCY THAT WILL ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM IN A COUNTY AN AGENCY APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 130H OF THIS SUBTITLE, TO ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM AT THE COUNTY LEVEL.
 - (C) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES.
- (D) "EMERGENCY FOOD PROVIDER" MEANS A NONPROFIT OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT-RUN ORGANIZATION, INCLUDING A SOUP KITCHEN OR FOOD PANTRY, WHICH PROVIDES FOOD TO NEEDY INDIVIDUALS AT NO CHARGE.
- (E) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE MARYLAND EMERGENCY FOOD PROGRAM.

- (A) (1) <u>SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS IN THE STATE BUDGET</u>, THERE IS A MARYLAND EMERGENCY FOOD PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES.
