- (D) "EMERGENCY FOOD PROVIDER" MEANS A NONPROFIT OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT-RUN ORGANIZATION, INCLUDING A SOUP KITCHEN OR FOOD PANTRY, WHICH PROVIDES FOOD TO NEEDY INDIVIDUALS AT NO CHARGE.
- (E) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE MARYLAND EMERGENCY FOOD PROGRAM.

 130G.
- (A) (1) <u>SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS IN THE STATE BUDGET</u>, THERE IS A MARYLAND EMERGENCY FOOD PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES.
- (2) THE COMMUNITY SERVICES ADMINISTRATION IN THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MANAGE THE PROGRAM.
- (B) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROCRAM IS TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO ASSIST EMERGENCY FOOD PROVIDERS IN PURCHASING FOOD FOR NEEDY INDIVIDUALS.
 - (B) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO:
- (1) PROVIDE FUNDING TO ASSIST EMERGENCY FOOD PROVIDERS IN PURCHASING FOOD FOR NEEDY INDIVIDUALS; AND
- (2) ENCOURAGE NEEDY INDIVIDUALS TO BECOME SELF-SUFFICIENT;
- (3) <u>DISTRIBUTE INFORMATION ON MARYLAND'S EARNED INCOME TAX</u>
 CREDIT.
- (C) (1) NO MORE THAN 8% 5% OF THE PROGRAM'S BUDGET MAY BE USED TO COVER PROGRAM ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS.
- (2) ALL REMAINING FUNDING SHALL BE ALLOCATED FOR FOOD PURCHASE ONLY.
- (3) NO PROGRAM FUNDS MAY BE USED FOR EQUIPMENT OR FOR ANY OTHER CAPITAL EXPENDITURES.

 130H.
- (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DESIGNATE AN ADOPT REGULATIONS TO SELECT AND APPROVE A SINGLE ADMINISTERING AGENCY TO ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM IN EACH COUNTY.
- (B) THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE:
- (1) STANDARDS AND CRITERIA TO ENSURE THAT THE SELECTED ADMINISTERING AGENCY HAS ADEQUATE INTERNAL CONTROLS OVER CASH RECEIPTS, MATERIALS, SUPPLIES, AND INVENTORIES; AND
- (2) A DEFINITION OF "UNITS OF SERVICE" WHICH SHALL BE USED TO TRACK PROGRAM UTILIZATION.
