(e) Class C licenses for the sale of beer, wine and liquor, as authorized by this article, shall be issued for places of business located in the 3rd election district.

(f) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this section wine may be sold as provided under a winery license, a limited winery license, or a Class A light wine license in any election district.

(g) (1) The restrictions in this section and in § 7-101(g) of this article do not apply to licenses issued pursuant to this subsection.

(2) The following entities may obtain a license for the sale of beer, wine and liquor:

- (i) Middletown Volunteer Fire Company;
- (ii) Wolfsville Volunteer Fire Company;
- (iii) Jefferson Volunteer Fire Company; and
- (iv) Myersville Volunteer Fire Company.

(3) All net proceeds from the sale of alcoholic beverages for the entities listed in paragraph (2) of this subsection shall be used solely to purchase fire and rescue equipment, for operating expenses, and for constructing and maintaining the buildings which house the emergency equipment.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That before this Act becomes legally effective it shall first be submitted to a referendum of the legally qualified voters of the 14th Election District of Frederick County at the general election to be held in November of 1998. The cost of the special election, if any, shall be paid by the Board of County Commissioners. The Board of County Commissioners and the Board of Supervisors of Elections of Frederick County shall do those things necessary and
