- (I) POLICE UNIFORM WHICH PROMINENTLY DISPLAYS THE OFFICER'S BADGE OR OTHER INSIGNIA OF OFFICE: OR
- (II) VEHICLE APPROPRIATELY MARKED AS AN OFFICIAL POLICE VEHICLE.
- (3) "VISUAL OR AUDIBLE SIGNAL" INCLUDES ANY SIGNAL BY HAND, VOICE, EMERGENCY LIGHT, OR SIREN.
