- (e) If a police officer gives a visual or audible signal to stop and the police officer is in uniform, prominently displaying the police officer's badge-or other insignia of office, a driver may not attempt to clude the police officer by leeing:
 - (1) IN A VEHICLE:
 - (2) [on] ON foot[.
- (d) If a police officer gives a visual or audible signal to stop and the police officer is in uniform, prominently displaying the police officer's badge or other insignia of office, a driver may not attempt to clude the police officer by]; OR
 - (3) BY any other means.
- [(e) If a police officer gives a visual or audible signal to stop and the police officer, whether or not in uniform, is in a vehicle appropriately marked as an official police vehicle, a driver of a vehicle may not attempt to clude the police officer by willfully failing to stop the driver's vehicle.
- (f) If a police officer gives a visual or audible signal to stop and the police officer, whether or not in uniform, is in a vehicle appropriately marked as an official police vehicle, a driver of a vehicle may not attempt to clude the police officer by fleeing on foot.
- (g) If a police officer gives a visual or audible signal to stop and the police officer, whether or not in uniform, is in a vehicle appropriately marked as an official police vehicle, a driver of a vehicle may not attempt to clude the police officer by any other means.]

- (p) (1) Except as provided in paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, any person who is convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of § 21-904 of this article ("Fleeing or eluding police") is subject to:
- (i) For a first offense, a fine of not more than \$1,000, or imprisonment for not more than 1 year, or both; and
- (ii) For any subsequent offense, a fine of not more than \$1,000, or imprisonment for not more than 2 years, or both.
- (2) Any person who is convicted of a violation of § 21-904-[(b) or (e)] of this article that results in bodily injury to another person—] OR PROPERTY DAMAGE CAUSED BY THE FLEEING INDIVIDUAL OR A PURSUING OFFICER is subject to a fine of not more than [\$3,000] \$5,000, or imprisonment for not more than [3] § 3 years, or both.
