(f) After December 31, 1992, the Public Service Commission shall give due consideration to the need to minimize the loss of forest and the provisions for afforestation and reforestation set forth in this subtitle together with all applicable electrical safety codes, when reviewing applications for a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued pursuant to [§§ 54A and 54B or § 54-I of Article 78 of the Code] § 7-204, § 7-205, § 7-207, OR § 7-208 OF THE PUBLIC UTILITY COMPANIES ARTICLE.

Article - Public Utility Companies

(g) "Electric plant" means the material, equipment, and property owned by an electric company AND USED OR TO BE USED FOR OR IN CONNECTION WITH ~~ELECTRICAL~~ ELECTRIC SERVICE.

(j) "Gas plant" means the material, equipment, and property owned by a gas company AND USED OR TO BE USED FOR OR IN CONNECTION WITH GAS SERVICE.

(q) (1) "Railroad" means a common carrier by rail powered in any manner.

(2) "Railroad" includes [branches, bridges, cars, extensions, ferries, plant, spurs, stations, subways, switches, terminal facilities, tracks, tunnels, and equipment] MATERIAL, EQUIPMENT, AND PROPERTY used on or in connection with a railroad.

(aa) "Telegraph lines" means the material, equipment, and property owned by a telegraph company AND USED OR TO BE USED FOR OR IN CONNECTION WITH TELEGRAPH SERVICE.

(cc) "Telephone lines" means the material, equipment, and property owned by a telephone company AND USED OR TO BE USED FOR OR IN CONNECTION WITH TELEPHONE SERVICE.

(gg) "Water plant" means the material, equipment, and property owned by a water company AND USED OR TO BE USED FOR OR IN CONNECTION WITH WATER SERVICE.

(b) (3) A Chairman who is appointed after a term has begun serves [only] for the rest of the term and until a successor qualifies.

(e) (2) The complaint filed under paragraph (1) of this subsection FOR THE FIRST TIME IN A PROCEEDING shall be served on the person that is the subject of the complaint before any hearing on the matter.
