- (D) IN ACCORDANCE WITH AN APPROVED AND REGISTERED WORK BASED LEARNING PROGRAM, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL HIRE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT INDIVIDUALS WHO:
- (1) DEMONSTRATE POTENTIAL FOR BEING SUCCESSFUL EMPLOYEES IN THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY: AND
- (2) ARE SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENTS, INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE RECEIVED A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA, INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE ENROLLED IN A PROGRAM TO RECEIVE A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR EQUIVALENCY, OR INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE ATTENDING AN INSTITUTION OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION ARE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:
  - (I) AN-INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENT;
- (II) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS RECEIVED A HICH SCHOOL DIPLOMA AND IS LESS THAN 22 YEARS OF AGE;
- (III) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS ENROLLED IN A PROGRAM TO RECEIVE A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR EQUIVALENCY; OR
- (IV) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS ATTENDING AN INSTITUTION OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION.
- <u>SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:</u>
- (a) There shall be a Task Force to Study School Construction Work-Based Learning and Apprenticeship Programs consisting of the following members:
- (1) 1 member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of the Senate;
- (2) <u>1 member of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the House;</u>
- (3) 3 representatives from each of three county boards of education active in work-based learning programs, appointed by the Governor;
- (4) The State Superintendent of Schools, or a designee of the State Superintendent;
- (5) <u>1</u> representative from the Interagency Committee on School Construction, appointed by the Governor;
- (6) 2 members of the Building and Construction Trades Council, appointed by the Governor;
- (7) 2 training directors from an apprenticeship program approved by the Apprenticeship and Training Council, appointed by the Secretary of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation:
- (8) 2 representatives from the Associated Building Contractors
  Associated, appointed by the Secretary of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation; and
