- (9) 1 student enrolled in a work-based learning program, appointed by the State Superintendent of Schools.
 - (b) The Governor shall designate the Chairman of the Task Force.
- (c) The Task Force shall conduct a study of existing school construction work-based learning and apprenticeship programs, including:
- (1) The number of individuals who have participated in such programs and the length of their participation;
- (2) The number of individuals who have participated in such programs who are members of a group that is disadvantaged socially or economically; and
- (3) The number of individuals who have entered an apprenticeship program in the construction industry after participating in such programs.
- (d) On or before December 15, 1999, the Task Force shall submit to the Governor and, subject to § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly a report that contains the findings of the study conducted by the Task Force, and the recommendations of the Task Force on how to expand and improve the work-based learning and apprenticeship programs involved with public school construction programs statewide.
- (e) Staff for the Task Force shall be provided by the Maryland State Department of Education and the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998 June 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 657

(Senate Bill 794)

AN ACT concerning

State-Aided Educational Institutions - Criteria for Qualifying

FOR the purpose of specifying the criteria for qualification as a State-aided educational institution; requiring educational institutions to submit certain requests and certain applications to the Department by a certain date; requiring the Department to review the applications from educational institutions and submit a list of qualified institutions to the State Superintendent of Schools for approval review and comment at a certain time; requiring the State Superintendent to select institutions for approval from the list-and forward the list-of approved institutions provide certain information to the State Board after a certain meeting to submit the list of institutions with final approval certain information to the Governor for funding approval; making this Act an emergency measure;
