- (6) EVIDENCE OF THE PROVISION OF A DIRECT SERVICE TO MARYLAND SCHOOL GROUPS OR TO INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES, INCLUDING:
  - (I) DATA ON AGE LEVELS OF STUDENTS TO BE SERVED;
- (II) DATA ON THE PROJECTED NUMBER OF STUDENTS AND TEACHERS TO BE SERVED BOTH STATEWIDE AND BY LOCAL JURISDICTION: AND
- (III) PLANS OF THE INSTITUTION TO SUPPORT THE GOALS OF THE MARYLAND SCHOOLS FOR SUCCESS PROGRAM AND THE MARYLAND SCHOOL PERFORMANCE PROGRAM; AND
  - (7) EVIDENCE OF LIABILITY INSURANCE COVERAGE.

AN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION THAT SEEKS TO QUALIFY AS A STATE-AIDED EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION FOR FUNDING IN THE FISCAL YEAR FOLLOWING THE UPCOMING FISCAL YEAR SHALL SUBMIT BEFORE MAY 1 TO THE MARYLAND STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION:

- (1) AN AUGMENTATION REQUEST DESCRIBING:
  - (I) WHO WILL BE SERVED;
  - (II) THE OBJECTIVES OF THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM; AND
  - (III) THE ANTICIPATED OUTCOMES:
- (2) AN APPLICATION FOR QUALIFICATION AS A STATE-AIDED EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION; AND
- (3) SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION AS DESCRIBED IN § 5–501 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REVIEW APPLICATIONS FOR QUALIFICATION AS A STATE-AIDED EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION AND SHALL SUBMIT A LIST OF THE QUALIFIED INSTITUTIONS TO THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS IN JUNE. 5–504.

## THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL:

- (1) <u>SELECT INSTITUTIONS FOR APPROVAL FROM REVIEW AND COMMENT ON THE INSTITUTIONS ON</u> THE LIST OF QUALIFIED INSTITUTIONS <u>AND THE EXTENT AND MANNER IN WHICH EACH WOULD FORWARD THE GOALS OF THE MARYLAND SCHOOLS FOR SUCCESS PROGRAM AND THE MARYLAND SCHOOL PERFORMANCE PROGRAM; AND</u>
- (2) PRESENT THE LIST OF APPROVED QUALIFIED INSTITUTIONS AND COMMENTS ON EACH INSTITUTION TO THE STATE BOARD AT THE JULY MEETING FOR FINAL APPROVAL REVIEW AND COMMENT BY THE BOARD AT THE AUGUST MEETING.
