SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the initial members of the Board of Directors shall expire as follows:

- (1)  $\frac{2}{4}$  members in 2002;
- (2) 2 3 members in 2001;
- (3) 2 3 members in 2000; and
- (4) 1 member in 1999.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That any faculty and staff of a public institution of higher education in the State that are assigned to the Corporation shall retain their employment status under the public institution of higher education, without any diminution of rights or benefits, including, if any, merit system and retirement status and shall continue to receive their salaries from the public institution of higher education.

SECTION 3. 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1998.

(House Bill 28)

## Higher Education - Professional School Scholarship Program - Social Work
