- (b) (2) If a private passenger motor vehicle insurance policy issued, sold, or delivered in the State includes:
- (I) collision coverage under this section OR ANY COMPREHENSIVE COVERAGE, the motor vehicles insured under that coverage shall include any passenger car that is rented by an insured for a period of 30 days or less under a rental agreement as otherwise defined in § 14–2101 of the Commercial Law Article; OR
- (II) COMPREHENSIVE COVERAGE, THE MOTOR VEHICLES INSURED UNDER THAT COVERAGE SHALL INCLUDE ANY REPLACEMENT VEHICLE AS DEFINED UNDER § 18–102(A)(2)(I) OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

(House Bill 173)

AN ACT concerning

Maintenance Drug Prescriptions – Supply Quantity – Repeal of Termination Date and Alteration of Application

FOR the purpose of repealing a certain termination date for and altering the application of a provision of law that requires certain health insurers, nonprofit health service plans, and health maintenance organizations to allow an insured or enrollee to receive a certain supply quantity of a maintenance drug in a single dispensing under certain circumstances; and altering the quantity of a certain maintenance drug that may be supplied in a single dispensing of a prescription.
