YEARS, THE INCREASE IN THE ACCRUED LIABILITY DETERMINED UNDER § 21–304(D)(5) OF THIS SUBTITLE THAT IS ATTRIBUTABLE TO THE RETIREMENT OF MEDICAL SYSTEM UNIVERSITY PERSONNEL, AS DEFINED IN § 13–301(Q) OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE, BY MEANS OF ANNUAL PAYMENTS THAT INCREASE EACH YEAR BASED ON ACTUARIAL ASSUMPTIONS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE ACTUARY.

## (2) THE MEDICAL SYSTEM:

- (I) SHALL PAY TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES THE AMOUNT REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION ON JULY 1 OF EACH YEAR UNTIL THE INCREASE IN THE ACCRUED LIABILITY IS PAID IN FULL; AND
- (II) MAY PREPAY ALL OR A PORTION OF THE INCREASE IN THE ACCRUED LIABILITY IN ACCORDANCE WITH A CALCULATION APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

## SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

- (1) A Except as provided under subsection (2) of this section, a member of the Employees' Retirement System or the Employees' Pension System may retire if the member:
- (i) submits a written application to the Board of Trustees from July 1, 1998 through August 31, 1998, inclusive;
- (ii) is an employee of the University System of Maryland on June 1, 1998;
- (iii) is a member of the respective Retirement or Pension System on January 1, 1998, as reflected in the records of the State Retirement Agency; and
  - (iv) on or before June 30, 1999:
    - 1. has at least 30 years of creditable service;
    - 2. A. has at least 25 years of creditable service; and
    - B. is at least 50 years old; or
- 3. is otherwise eligible to retire under  $\S$  22–401,  $\S$  22–402,  $\S$  23–401, or  $\S$  23–402 of the State Personnel and Pensions Article.
- Pension System who is deemed a State employee for retirement purposes and who was an employee of the Medical System, as defined in § 13-301(k) of the Education Article, or the University System of Maryland, on January 1, 1997 and is separated from employment as a result of the elimination of the employee's position by the Medical System or as a result of the elimination of the member's position in the State budget or by budget amendment or as a result of legislative action reducing the State budget after January 1, 1998 and before July 1, 1998 1999 may retire if the member:
