(House Bill 206)

AN ACT concerning

Consumer Protection - "Lemon Law" for Motorcycles

FOR the purpose of extending application of the Maryland Automotive Warranty Enforcement Act to motorcycles by altering the definition of a "motor vehicle" to include a vehicle that is registered in this State as a Class D (motorcycle) vehicle.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14-1501.

(a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

(c) (1) "Motor vehicle" means a vehicle that is registered in this State as a:

(i) Class A (passenger) vehicle;

(II) CLASS D (MOTORCYCLE) VEHICLE;

[(ii)] (III) Class E (truck) vehicle with a 3/4 ton or less manufacturer's rated capacity; or
