

[(iii)] (IV) Class M (multipurpose) vehicle.

(2) "Motor vehicle" does not include a motor home. For the purpose of administering this subtitle, the Motor Vehicle Administration shall promulgate a regulation defining a motor home.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

(House Bill 209)

AN ACT concerning

State Aid for Public Education – Schools for Success – Extension of Sunset

FOR the purpose of extending the termination of certain provisions relating to challenge grants for school improvement; and generally relating to State aid for public education.

Section 2

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Education

5-204.

(a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

(2) "Challenge grants" means funds distributed by the Department for use in accountability of low-performing schools for school improvement based upon Schools for Success goals.

(3) "Data-based areas" means those areas identified by the Department for which information is to be tracked for each school, each school system, and the State related to the 10 Schools for Success goals.
