SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Labor and Employment

9-682.

- (c) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the employer or its insurer shall pay the weekly death benefit:
 - (1) for the period of partial dependency; or
- (2) (1) FOR A PARTLY DEPENDENT SPOUSE, UNTIL \$45,000 HAS BEEN PAID; AND
- (II) FOR ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL, until \$17,500 \$45,000 has been paid.
- (d) (1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, if a surviving spouse who is partly dependent remarries and does not have dependent children at the time of the remarriage, the employer or its insurer shall make payments to the surviving spouse for 2 years after the date of the remarriage.
- (2) The total of the payments made before the remarriage may not exceed [\$17,500] \$45,000.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this Act shall apply to any death occurring on or after October 1, 1998.

SECTION 2. 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

(House Bill 452)

AN ACT concerning

Department of Housing and Community Development - Rental Housing Production Program - Office and Commercial Space Conversion

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Housing and Community Development to provide financial assistance through the Rental Housing Production Program for conversion of office and other commercial space to
