- (b) (1) Commissioners shall be adult residents of the counties in which they serve, but they need not be lawyers.
- [(2) The salary of commissioners shall be set by the Secretary of Budget and Management.
- (3)] (2) Each commissioner shall hold office at the pleasure of the Chief Judge of the District Court, and has the powers and duties prescribed by law.
- [(4)](3) Except without additional compensation, unless otherwise fixed by law, an employee of the District Court, who is an adult, may be granted, in the same manner, commissioner powers and duties in the county where [he] THE EMPLOYEE is employed.

All positions in the Judicial Branch of State government are excluded from the State Personnel Management System except[:

- (1) the positions in the District Court of Maryland that are listed in \S 6-401(b) of this title; or
 - (2)] as otherwise provided by law.

6-401.

- (a) Except as provided in this title or otherwise by law, all positions in the Executive Branch of State government that are included in the State Personnel Management System are in the skilled service.
- I(b) Except as otherwise provided by law, the following positions in the Judicial Branch of State government are in the skilled service:
- (1) clerical and administrative positions in the District Court of Maryland; and
 - (2) full-time constables in the District Court of Maryland.
- (c)] (B) The skilled service includes any other position that is specified by law to be in the skilled service.

(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, this subtitle applies to :
