

CHAPTER 763

(Senate Bill 257)

AN ACT concerning

Deer - Seasons and Bonus Stamps

FOR the purpose of altering certain provisions relating to deer stamps; eliminating certain provisions relating to deer hunting in Dorchester County; providing that a bonus deer stamp purchased in one season may be used in a subsequent season during the same hunting year; altering ~~certain fees~~ a certain fee; providing for the effective date of this Act; and generally relating to deer and hunting.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

10-301.

(f) (6) The fees for individual hunting stamps are according to the following schedule:

(i) Deer stamp .....	\$9.50
(ii) Bow and arrow stamp .....	\$3.50
(iii) Black powder stamp .....	\$3.50
(iv) Maryland migratory wild waterfowl stamp .....	\$6.00
(v) Resident [second] BONUS deer stamp for each type of deer hunting season .....	<del>[\$5.00]</del> \$10
(vi) Nonresident [second] BONUS deer stamp for each type of deer hunting season .....	<del>[\$10.00]</del> \$25

10-415.

(a) There are the following 3 seasons to hunt deer:

- (1) A bow hunting season;
- (2) A firearms season; and
- (3) A muzzle loader season.
