AN ACT concerning

Deer - Seasons and Bonus Stamps

FOR the purpose of altering certain provisions relating to deer stamps; eliminating certain provisions relating to deer hunting in Dorchester County; providing that a bonus deer stamp purchased in one season may be used in a subsequent season during the same hunting year; altering eertain fees a certain fee; providing for the effective date of this Act; and generally relating to deer and hunting.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(1)	Deer stamp\$9.50
(ii)	Bow and arrow stamp \$3.50

- (iv) Maryland migratory wild waterfowl stamp...... \$6.00
- - (a) There are the following 3 seasons to hunt deer:
 - (1) A bow hunting season;
 - (2) A firearms season; and
 - (3) A muzzle loader season.
