

(d) The Board may[:

(1) Extend] EXTEND a temporary license to complete a preceptorship[;

or

(2) Renew a temporary license once for an additional term under subsection (c) of this section, if the holder:

(i) Otherwise meets the requirements of this section;

(ii) Submits a renewal application to the Board on the form that the Board requires; and

(iii) Pays to the Board a temporary license renewal fee set by the Board].

(e) The Board shall issue a license to replace the temporary license of a holder, if the Board receives:

(1) The passing test scores of the holder; and

(2) Any other document that the Board requires.

Subject to the hearing provisions of § 13-317 of this subtitle, the Board may deny a license, temporary license, or restricted license to any applicant, reprimand any licensee or holder of a temporary license or restricted license, place any licensee or holder of a temporary license or restricted license on probation, or suspend or revoke a license, temporary license, or restricted license if the applicant, licensee, or holder:

(1) Fraudulently or deceptively obtains or attempts to obtain a license, temporary license, or restricted license for the applicant, licensee, or holder or for another;

(2) Fraudulently or deceptively uses a license, temporary license, or restricted license;

(3) Practices physical therapy inconsistent with any written or oral order of:

(i) A physician authorized to practice medicine in any state;

(ii) A dentist authorized to practice dentistry in any state; or

(iii) A podiatrist authorized to practice podiatry in any state;

(4) Unless specifically licensed with respect to the treatment, treats or attempts to treat a health condition of an individual by means other than physical therapy;
