13-306.

(a) An applicant who otherwise qualifies for a license is entitled to be examined for that license as provided in this section.

(b) The Board shall give examinations at least twice a year, at the times and places that the Board determines, to applicants for:

- (1) A physical therapy license; and
- (2) A physical therapist assistant license.

(c) The Board OR ITS AGENT shall[:

(1) Notify each qualified applicant of the time and place of examination; and

(2) Publish notice of the time and place of each examination given under this subtitle:

(i) At least one time in a daily newspaper of general circulation in this State; and

(ii) In any other manner that the Board determines] NOTIFY EACH QUALIFIED APPLICANT OF THE TIME AND PLACE OF THE EXAMINATION.

(d) The Board shall determine the subjects, scope, form, and passing score for examinations given under this subtitle.

13-313.

(a) (1) Subject to the provisions of this section, the Board shall issue a temporary license to an applicant who:

(i) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection and except for the examination requirements of this subtitle, has met the appropriate licensing requirements of this title to the satisfaction of the Board;
