SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

~~(A) IN THE CIRCUIT COURTS IN EACH COUNTY FULL TIME STATE STANDING MASTERS SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE CIRCUIT ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE OF A JUDICIAL CIRCUIT IN CONSULTATION WITH THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS.~~

~~(B) STATE STANDING MASTERS APPOINTED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL:~~

~~(1) REPORT TO AND PERFORM THE DUTIES AND THE ASSIGNMENTS DETERMINED BY THE CIRCUIT ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE OF A JUDICIAL CIRCUIT, AND~~

~~(2) BE OFFICERS OF THE STATE.~~

~~(C) THE COMPENSATION OF STATE STANDING MASTERS SHALL:~~

~~(1) BE UNIFORM THROUGHOUT THE STATE;~~

~~(2) BE DETERMINED BY THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS, AND~~

~~(3) BE INCLUDED IN THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE JUDICIARY DEPARTMENT OF MARYLAND BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2001.~~

~~(D) THIS SECTION DOES NOT REQUIRE A CURRENT POSITION OF STANDING MASTER TO BE CONVERTED TO A STATE STANDING MASTER.~~

~~(E) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, STATE STANDING MASTERS SHALL BE MEMBERS OF THE STATE EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM.~~
