(House Bill 71)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Emissions Inspection Program - Retest Waivers - Repair Expenditures

FOR the purpose of extending ~~indefinitely~~ the period during which a certain expenditure on emissions related vehicle repairs will qualify the vehicle owner for a waiver from certain vehicle exhaust emissions retests under the State's vehicle emissions inspection program; ~~repealing a provision of law that requires altering the date on or after which~~ a vehicle owner, in order to qualify for an exhaust emissions retest waiver ~~after a certain date~~, is required to spend an amount specified in federal law on emissions related repairs; clarifying language; and generally relating to the vehicle emissions inspection program.
